What does the PPG do?

We focus on supporting the surgery and its patient community, together with building links between the two in order to improve the patient experience.

What the PPG is not about

We will not deal with personal medical issues or individual patient complaints as there is already a well established procedure to deal with these.

Our Achievements

The members of the PPG committee have worked together to implement new ideas, increase health awareness in the community and support the practice.

Some of the purchases and support that the PPG has provided for the surgery and patient community in recent times are as follows:

- Spare vaccine fridge enabling the vaccination of hundreds of patients at COVID/flu clinics in a single day.
- Blood pressure monitors available to be loaned for home monitoring
- Special bariatric chair for the waiting room
- Handheld 12 lead ECGs, used by GPs and nurses to detect potential heart problems in patients without them needing a full ECG
- Supporting a new clinical room, resulting in extra space for more staff, by kitting out and transforming an area previously used for storage.
- Provision and fitting of specific ceiling mounted lighting to support the practice's ongoing minor surgery, vasectomy and women's health clinics.
- Replacement defibrillator
- Electric three section bariatric couch, especially suitable for suitable for patients with higher body weights or additional movement needs.
- Replacement INR machine
- Doppler machine for use out in the community with patients who are housebound or have mobility issues
- Organising CPR and defibrillator training sessions to support our patient community
- Organising a 'First Aid for Children' training evening to support people looking after young children, such as new parents, grandparents and babysitters
- Input to the new 'Falls Assessment Service' which is now provided by the practice
- Organising weekly Health Walks
- Organising a Christmas Party for patients aged over 75.
- Printing a quarterly PPG Newsletter
- Submitting regular 'latest news' articles about the surgery in three village newsletters

We are a committed and proactive committee and we would welcome your ideas for future projects.

How do we finance our activities?
